History of Victory & VEF

Victory is a part of the Chinese Lutheran Brethren Church. Currently there are about 17 Lutheran Brethren churches in Taiwan with sister synods in Japan, Chad, Cameroon, the United States, and Canada.

Victory was founded in 1954 when a missionary's daughter donated money to buy a small evangelistic house. In 1954 a small tea house was bought at the present location. Victory Church officially opened on March 13th, 1955. The current building was completed in 1996.

Victory English Fellowship has its beginnings in 1994 when an English Sunday school was started in 1994 in response to the growing number of Chinese returning to Hsinchu to work in the Science Park. The first English services started in 1998 under the Youth Department, in fact VEF was then called English HS Fellowship, then it changed to Victory Church English Youth Fellowship, and finally to Victory English Fellowship as it's known today.
